RATIONALE:

The rationale for The Challenge is simple. Linemen are an elite group of young men; a group of young men who may have more of an impact on the flow of the game than any other position group involved. The problem is that, although they are valued greatly, their efforts are often overshadowed by those of the "skill position" players. This challenge presents an opportunity to showcase the many talents of the players who play in football's most overlooked, but most valuable positions.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION - 9:00 AM

1. BENCH PRESS

Players will complete as many proper repetitions of 185 lbs. as they can. Players must lower the weight to their chest and lock out their arms each time to count as a legitimate repetition. Feet must remain on the ground, and backs must remain flat on the bench (no arching).

1st Tiebreaker (225)

2nd Tiebreaker = add 10 pounds until a winner is declared

2. ONE-MAN BEAST SLED

Players will be timed as they push the one-man beast sled 20 yards. Contestants must stay within the course, which will be about 10 feet wide. The beast is made of pressure-treated wood and is about 4 feet tall and 4 feet wide.

Tiebreaker - Beast "Push-off" (As far as you can push it!)

3. PRO AGILITY

Players will be timed as they compete in the Pro Agility cone drill. Each player must complete 2 attempts and their score will be determined by the sum of both attempts.

4. TRACTOR TIRE FLIP

Players will be timed as they flip a 230 lb. empty tractor tire 10 times. Players will have to flip it completely while at the same time staying within the course (lines 10 feet apart).

TEAM COMPETITION - APPROX. 11:00 AM

1. BUS PUSH

Teams of four will line up behind and be timed as they move an empty 48 passenger school bus 30 yards.

Tiebreaker - "4-Man Beast Sled" 400+ lb. Pressure-Treated Sled

2. OBSTACLE COURSE

Our physical education and football staff have developed a challenging course which players will have to run in "relay" style. Teams will have to decide who will run each leg of the course.

3. DUMBBELL RELAY

Starting at the goal line, players will carry two 80 lb. dumbbells to their partner who will be 25 yards away. This will continue up to the other end zone and will conclude when the team has made it back to the start. NOTE: Player 4 will have to walk 50 yards.

Tiebreaker - "4-Man Beast" 400+ lb. Pressure-Treated Sled

4. TEAM BENCH PRESS

Total repetitions will be added together from the individual contest.

Tiebreaker - 225 lbs. Team Bench Press

5. MYSTERY EVENT (Could be an individual or team event!)

This event is back for 2019 and is sure to be a hit once again! Information on this event will not be disclosed to anyone prior to the event-day coaches' meeting.

Finale: TUG-OF-WAR

Tournament bracket style depending on the number of teams entered. Bracket placement will be determined by the team rank (based on total points of all team events). Some of the top ranked teams may receive a bye in the first round. This is always a crowd favorite!

AWARDS CEREMONY - APPROX. 1:00 PM

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event. The "Iron Lineman" award goes to the athlete with the best cumulative score in all individual events. In the team events, each member of the top team in each contest will be awarded. In addition, the top three teams with the best cumulative scores in all events will be awarded.

- 4. All athletes will receive a challenge T-shirt and a coupon for lunch.
