2021 RECAP

The McKeesport Tigers were a play away from heading to Heinz. That doesn't take away from the Tigers memorable season. Taking down Thomas Jefferson at home handily was the highlight of the year. The Tigers offense exploded behind three talented backs. Now two of them are back including one that could set all sorts of records.

OFFENSE

BOBBIE BOYD JR., JAHMIL PERRYMAN and Kanye Thompson were the RB unit of the classification. Now with Thompson gone, but the former two back, get ready for more fireworks. BOYD JR. might even be the best RB at the 4A level not named Tikwai Hayes. Two key linemen graduate, but there's still plenty of depth back for the Tigers. QB is the biggest question mark with both of the guys who got time graduate. It looks like Perryman will be getting the initial start under center, meaning that this offense may be even more explosive than in recent years.

DEFENSE

The McKeesport defense was dominant and then some in 2021. The highlight was only giving up 14 to one of the top offenses in the WPIAL in Armstrong. DIMITRI BROOKS is the big name back up front, he'll be joined by several talented young prospects. Every position group elsewhere is loaded.

OVERVIEW

One of the biggest problems with ranking McKeesport in 2021 was the fact they scheduled Canisius (NY) to play while other teams in their conference took the bye week. McKeesport lost which not only hurt their state and WPIAL ranking, but even their playoff seed compared with TJ and BV. The Tigers didn't learn the lesson and come back with another incredibly difficult schedule. This time the Tigers visit 5A champions Penn Trafford, host 5A semi playoff team Gateway and 4A silver medalist Belle Vernon. Those out of conference games combined with the home finale against Thomas Jefferson will make this season the most interesting in McKeesport history. The Tigers have the talent to win the 4A WPIAL title, but also the schedule to watch it all fall apart.

2021 RECAP

Greater Latrobe experienced a 2021 season full of close losses and blowouts. In the end, a 40-41 loss to Franklin Regional kept the Wildcats out of the 5A WPIAL playoffs. Now the Wildcats drop down a classification, and although there will be plenty of attrition from last season to this one, there's plenty of optimism that Latrobe can find their footing in the Big Eight.

OFFENSE

The Wildcats lose their top player in QB Bobby Fetter. COREY BOERIO looks to be the top candidate to move from TE to his natural position at QB, JOHN WETZLE will be in the mix as well. ALEX TETSCH emerged as a viable weapon in the ground game for the Wildcats. The receiving corps is nearly completely intact from a year ago. STEVENS, BUTINA and FLENNIKEN will all play a key role for the Wildcats. The Line is where there will be the most gaps that need to be filled in.

DEFENSE

Greater Latrobe struggled to get off of the field to even middling teams in 5A a season ago. Now in a new classification, this is the time for drastic improvement. There's young talent across the board. CODY KRALL on the defensive line will emerge as a top pass rusher. RILEY SMITH at LB will look to emerge as well.



COREY BOERIO

OVERVIEW

The Wildcats might be the biggest wildcard in the entire division. They don't have the top end talent to beat a Thomas Jefferson or a McKeesport, but they have enough depth and talent across the board to compete with everyone else. The Wildcats have a stretch in the middle of the season starting with Laurel Highlands and ending with Connellsville that will decide if Latrobe will be in the playoffs or not. There's a more than better chance that the Wildcats can sweep all four of those games and enter the playoffs as the second best team in the conference. At the worst, the Wildcats just barely miss the playoffs as the 5th best team in the Big Eight. Latrobe will find quickly enough that Trinity, Ringgold and Connellsville aren't the on the level of Gateway and Penn Trafford.

Instead of looking like a fish out of water against the Jaguars and the Tigers, it would be a huge step in the right direction to be competitive in those games. It might also show a hope for the future after GALLAGHER's senior season.

OFFENSE

Trinity will also host Carrick before heading to Ringgold to wrap up the season, meaning if the Knause administration finds an identity, those final two games will be the perfect opportunity to showcase it.
