2021 RECAP

Upper St Clair rode an established identity of grit and grind to a second place finish in the Allegheny Six. Only three points separated the Panthers from an undefeated conference season and a title. Ethan Heister was the Panthers do it all star, from torching defenses in the ground game to leveling quarterbacks on defense. A disappointing playoff run ended the Panthers season in 2021, and although the Panthers lose their best player over the offseason, there's plenty more to be excited about for 2022.

OFFENSE

Although the Panthers lose Heister there's depth everywhere else. BRODY ERDOS returns at QB and he'll have a much larger role than last year. AIDAN BESSELMAN is a dynamic talent that will eat defenses alive. JAMAAL BROWN could be the heir apparent to the punishing style of running Heister showed. If the line play stays consistent watch for the Panthers offense to take a huge step.

DEFENSE

The Panthers defense was punishing down the back half of last season. With most of the D-Line coming back with ZACH EHASZ and MARK BANBURY, the Panthers will once again have a strong unit, maybe the best in the classification.



OVERVIEW

This might be their year. Aside from a mid season road matchup with the 6A state champs, there's isn't a game on the schedule the Panthers won't have a solid chance to win. A road non conference game against Fox Chapel will also be a fun test to see two of the up and coming programs in the classification face off. Peters Township, Moon and Bethel Park will be the primary competition for the conference title, and they'll have two of those at home. As one of the only returning QBs in the conference, BRODY ERDOS has the chance to be the best and most talented if he's given a longer leash. Just like in 2021, the defense will win the Panthers games all season. If the offense can truly transform, the Panthers may not just have a conference title team on their hands.

2021 RECAP

Bethel Park found their identity in 2021. The Blackhawks followed up a winless 2020 season with a memorable regular season and a playoff berth. Going into the following two games of the year, the Blackhawks even had a chance to win the whole conference. This easo, they'll have a team ready to make that goal a reality.

OFFENSE

The Blackhawks will have to fight through the losses of QB Maxwell Blanc and top athlete Troy Volpatti on offense. At QB, there's a big question mark and not a clear replacement. Whoever the QB will be, he will have a full assortment of weapons. Chief of those will be receiver duo RYAN PETRAS and JASON NUTTRIDGE. The offensive line is almost entirely intact as well. This offense is a short retool away from being one of the most complete in 5A.

DEFENSE

The Blackhawks had a sneakily good defense in 2021, that should continue. GAVIN MOUL will be the name to watch as a top college prospect. TYLER STEWART will be a good complement to make a top 5A LB tandem. The lines stocked with seniors and the secondary brings back AUSTIN CAYE. Watch out for Bethel Park to be one of the toughest teams to score against in the classification.



OVERVIEW

Bethel Park will be a better team than people give them credit for going into this season. Everything will rely on finding the right QB to go with on offense. The early season schedule won't give the Blackhawks a good chance to break him in, a 5A playoff team and then a back to back against the two 6A championship participants. In conference, however, everything really sets up for the Blackhawks. Three of the last four will be key. Bethel park will take on Upper St. Clair, Moon and Peters Township in a stretch that will determine if Bethel Park will be a low rung playoff team or a conference champion. In this crazy conference where it could be anyone's year, there's no reason why the Bethel Park Blackhawks can't be the last team standing, however they might be one or two key pieces away from the top.

2021 RECAP

Peters Township had one of the hottest and coldest seasons in recent memory. The Indians started off the year on a tear with big wins over Fox Chapel, Canon McMillan, and the eventual 5A champs in Penn Trafford. The Indians dropped their first three games in conference play, only to win out and make it to the 2nd round of the WPIAL playoffs. Now Peters might have all the pieces to go on deep run once again.

OFFENSE

Sam Miller shined at QB in 2022, and the Indians are hopeful that CHRIS CIBRONE will be a suitable replacement. The biggest name back on offense will be RICHIE WOODS, who had a breakout season at RB. There will be plenty of options at receiver with SHANAFELT, SCHRATZ, MILLER and MCCULLOUGH. The O-Line comes back with 3 starters and several depth pieces to be excited about as well.

DEFENSE

The Peters Township defense was dangerous in 2021, but they'll have to replace several key pass rushers. A name that could emerge is JAKE VELGICH. Across the defense there will be spots to fill in, but on the whole expect the same consistency and talent from Peters that one has come to expect.



OVERVIEW

The Indians battled through injuries in the middle of last season and were just barely able to survive, get healthy, and advance through the playoffs. Key players and position groups got experience in that stretch, which is something to be confident. Peters will have to travel to Moon, Upper St. Clair, and Bethel Park. OFFENSE

DEFENSE

OVERVIEW

Baldwin is an oddball in the Allegheny Six conference. If one goes by last years out of conference results, where the Highlanders got blown out by new conference opponents Bethel Park and Upper St. Clair, Baldwin could be a bottom feeder at the 5A level as well. Despite that, there's still optimism around the program and move down a classification. Baldwin's most winnable game all season will be at home against South Fayette late in the year. They could even be competitive with Moon in the home finale. For the rest of the schedule, it's tough to see many wins appearing. Baldwin has a very difficult road schedule, and likely won't win or even be competitive in any of them. For the Highlanders, 2022 is all about coming together as a younger team at the 5A level and showing promise.
