Last Seasons Recap: Central Catholic finished with a record of 7-5 overall and a 2-2 conference record. Central Catholic fell to the North Allegheny Tigers in the WPIAL 6A title game last season. They look to make their way back to the title game in the 2023 season. Central would go on to beat Mt. Lebanon Blue Devils in round one of the 6A bracket with only four teams making the playoffs for 6A in 2022. They would beat Mt. Lebanon 28-7 and then go on to lose to North Allegheny 35-21 in the title game.

Offensive Standouts: Senior QB Payton Wehner posted 2504 yards last season throwing 285 passes and completing 176 of them and 17 touchdowns. Leading receiver and Penn State football

commit Peter Gonzalez looks to prove he is a top commit. Last season Gonzalez posted 735 yards and 42 receptions and look to help this duo of Wehner and Gonzalez build a championship team for Central Catholic.

Central struggled last year with holding high powered offenses like North Allegheny and Mt.
