



Mt. Lebanon Preview:



Last Season Recap: The Mt. Lebanon Blue Devils struggled last season with missing the playoffs and losing two of their first four games last season. The 2021 state champions look to battle back in the 2023 season after last season's 5-6 campaign. The Blue Devils lost their last game to Central Catholic 28-7 which kicked them out of a chance at the WPIAL 6A playoffs.

Offensive Standouts: QB David Shields and Miami baseball commit had 93 completions after throwing 160 passes. David Shields had seven interceptions to only eight touchdowns in the 2022 season. Shields had 1031 total passing yards and looks to improve upon in the 2023 campaign. Leading rusher and 2024 grad Beckham Dee look to improve on his big season last year, Dee had 326 yards through 86 attempts and averaged 3.4 yards per carry last season.

Defensive Standouts: Mt. Lebanon lost their top two tacklers from the 2022 season, and they look to get some more production from third leading tackler and senior Beckham Dee who was third on the team with 3.0 tackles per game. Sack leader and senior Connor Young looks to build off his team leading 1.0 sacks/game last season and help put more pressure on Mt. Lebanon's opponents this season to help their defense.
