Last Season Schedule:

Last Season Recap: Last season was the second time in five years where North Hills finished with a losing record. That was also their second 3-win season on their last five season.

Offense: Starting QB John Green threw three yards shy of 900 yards but did throw for 10 TDs. Four different players had 100+ receiving yards with their leading receiver having only 293 yards (Cooper Thompson). Four different players also had 100+ rushing yards with their leading rusher having only 340 yards (Julius Green). The team's three wins came on a three-game win streak against Penn Hills, Fox Chapel and Shaler, two-out of three of those teams had winning records.
