

Baldwin Fighting Highlanders Allegheny Six



Recap: Baldwin last season finished with an overall record of 1-9, and a conference record of 0-5.

Offense: The Fighting Highlanders finished second to last with 83 points scored in conference competition only ahead of South Fayette (81) and finished second to last in total points scored in all 5A only ahead of Fox Chapel (56).

QB Nico Macurak, who found his way into the starting spot mid-way through the season, threw for only 670+ yards, 5 TDs

and 4 INTs, with roughly a 43% completion percentage. Baldwin only had three receivers with 200+ yards. The identity of the offense however came from now graduate Andrew Sharp. Sharp had over 1,000 rushing yards averaging six yards per carry and found the endzone 15 times.

Defense: Baldwin after shutting out Brashear in week 1, had seven games where they allowed 30+ points, and six games allowing 40+ points. Overall the defense allowed 38.8 points per game which was the second highest only behind Fox Chapel (42.5).
