



Greensburg Salem Golden Lions Interstate

Last Season: Greensburg Salem last season finished with an overall record of 2-8, and a conference record of 1-4.

Offense: The Golden Lions finished with 83 points scored in conference competition and were the sixth best team for the amount of points scored in the Interstate Conference. They finished fifteenth in conference points scored in all 3A right behind section rival South Allegheny (87).

Between all their games Greensburg Salem averaged 15.8 points. Freshman QB Brody Chismar had 640+ passing yards with 6 total TDS and 8 INTS. Alongside Chismar was then junior QB Peyton Chismar who had 330+ rushing yards with 3 total TDS and 5 INTS. Returning with the Chismars is senior wide receiver Dominic Rosensteel who had 550+ receiving yards with 4 TDS and an average of 62.7 yards per games. Also, returning is running backs Brady Smith, Kai Brunot and tight end Max Topper who had a combined 9 TDS. Joining them this season is newcomer tight end Brandon Ginder. Joining Ginder as a newcomer under the Friday night lights are O-Lineman Ender Cosgrove-Faust and Ayden Mars. The rest of the O-Line is made up of Cole Savage, Azzy Franklin and Jack McGough.

"We're looking forward to returning a lot of players with experience on both sides of the ball. We are excited for up the upcoming season and competing with the teams on our schedule this year." stated head coach Ty George.

Defense: Greensburg Salem allowed an average of 37.2 points last season between all their games. The Golden Lions allowed 205 points in conference play which was the fifth best in the Interstate conference with the next closest Mt. Pleasant (168). The team is returning
