Recap: The Moon Tigers finished with a 5-4 record in the regular season, however fell short losing in the second round of the WPIAL playoffs to the soon WPIAL 5A Champion Peters Township Indians 41-18.

Offense: Moon scored 305 total points last year, 157 of which was against conference opponents. This averages them to scoring 25.4 points per game. In their last five games, they scored 42 points three times, and 35 points another.

QB Andrew Cross led the team in passing
with over 400+ yards 5 TDs and 4 INTs.

While the Tigers only had one receiver with
over 100+ yards, Josh Bladel had over 1,000
on the ground. He averaged 5.6 yards per carry and had 14 total TDs.
