



Last Season: Mt. Pleasant last season finished with an overall record of 6-5, and a conference record of 2-3.

Offense: The Vikings finished with 115 points scored in conference competition and were the fourth best team for the amount of points scored in the Interstate Conference. They finished twelfth in conference points scored in all 3A, just one point better then Knoch (114).

Between all their games Mt. Pleasant averaged 25.1 points. QB Cole Chatfield, who is going into his senior year, had 1200+ passing yards with 14 TDS and 7

INTS. Chatfield also had 190+ rushing yards with 1 TD across 37 attempts. Not returning is running back Dante Giallonardo, who is committed to play at Washington and Jefferson this fall. He had 550+ rushing yards and 430 receiving yards with 9 total TDS. Someone who is returning is junior running back Brody Hutter who had 480+ rushing yards with 6 TDS. Other players who are also returning this season on the offense side of the ball include tight end Logan Parson, wide receiver Robert Hixson and senior Jarett Garn. Well, many of the offense is full of veteran players the O-Line is only returning one of their starters, the 6'5 245 pound tackle Carter Strayer. The rest of the O-Line will be all newcomers including juniors Dylan Pitzer, Charles Strader, Alex Ferencz, Payton Schaum, Michael Reese, Caleb Pease and sophomore Christian Brodak.

Defense: The Vikings allowed an average of 27.64 points last season between all their games. They struggled early on in the season against Greensburg Central Catholic and then later on the season against West Mifflin and section rivals Southmoreland and Belle Vernon where they gave a combined 172 points. But in the middle of the season the team did have some

solid score lines including a 27-13 win over Yough, a 25-6 win over Valley and a 38-7 win over Greensburg Salem.
